



1 | PREPARE & PROTECT

Identify and gather medications, sentimental items, and other heat-sensitive items listed in the Flare Prep Guide PDF. Items from vehicles will need to be brought in for treatment. Clothes and a large bag will need to be set aside in the bathroom for each person's return for the "Clean Swap" at the end of the process.



2 | ARRIVAL & SETUP

We arrive, process your payment, and let you leave. We will seal your gathered sensitive items in a box and place it in an insulated container. This container will keep the items safe during the treatment. We setup the space for treatment with our heaters and fans, and once active we secure your home with a specialized lock.

3 | THE HEAT TREATMENT

We raise the temperature in your home to 140°F to eliminate all bed bug life stages. High-powered fans circulate heat while we periodically enter the home to move furniture and cushions, ensuring no cold spots remain. We monitor the home in real-time to maintain the thermal death point for deep thermal penetration.

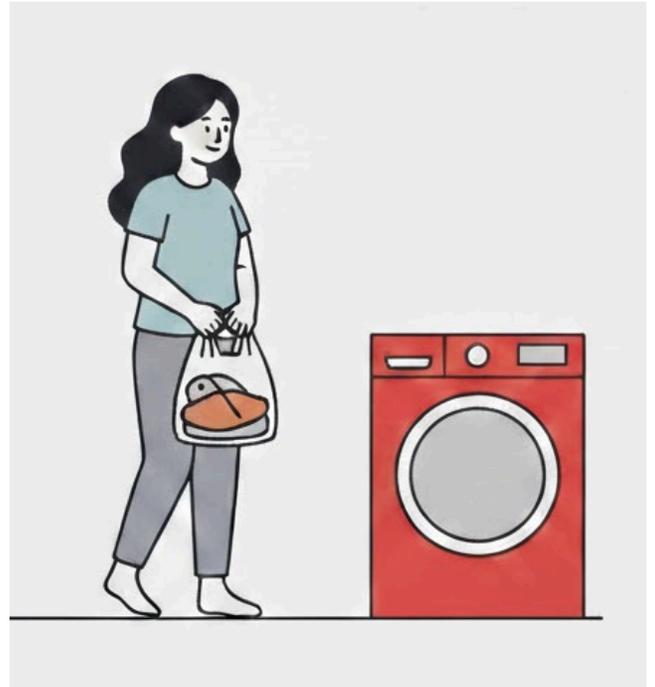


4 | PACK UP & RETURN

We pack up our equipment when finished and cool the space while making every effort to return items to their original positions. The thermostat is reset and windows may be left open to help return the temperature to normal. We will let you know when we are done and ready for you to return.

5 | THE "CLEAN SWAP"

Upon arrival, each resident will enter the residence and quickly change into the clothes you've set aside previously while putting old clothes and shoes into a provided bag. This "clean swap" ensures reinfestation doesn't occur in the treated home while we steam-treat and vacuum your vehicles.



6 | SLEEP TIGHT

Your treatment is done and your home is bed-bug-free! We take pride in leaving your home ready for you to settle back in. Ensure all pets are safe and comfortable as they are re-introduced to the space. The sealed boxes may be opened after a set amount of time to ensure our eco-friendly fumigant has killed any bugs or eggs inside the boxes.
